- 3. Ability to climb stairs and stand for extended periods (accommodations can be made).
- 4. Knowledge of the theater and its seating arrangements and emergency procedures.

Additional Requirements Needed For Specific Positions

- 1. Cash handling.
- 2. Fast-paced customer service skills.
- 3. Current OLCC server's permit (on file and in hand).
- 4. Leadership and managerial skills.
- 5. Assist with food or beverage service.
